GRADE EIGHT SUPPLY LIST

Please bring these items on the first day of school, Wednesday, September 7, 2022.

General Supplies – students are expected to come to all classes prepared with these items daily:

- Pencils
- Erasers
- Pens in blue, black, and red
- Highlighters
- 1 (one) pair of scissors
- Zipper Pouch
- Colored pencil set or Crayola marker set (may use previous year's set)
- College ruled notebook paper

Science:

- 1 (one) graph paper composition notebook
- 1 (one) 3" three-ring binder, hard cover
- 1 (one) scientific calculator model T.I. 30XA, non-graphing only

Math:

- 1 (one) scientific calculator model T.I. 30XA, non-graphing only (same as science)
- 1 (one) 1.5"-2" three-ring binder
- Three-hole punched ¼" grid graph paper
- Geometry students ONLY* - 1 (one) compass
- Geometry students ONLY* - 1 (one) protractor

English:

- 1 (one) bound composition notebook, hard cover
- 1 (one) folder with pockets
- 2 (two) three-hole punched spiral notebooks, 70-100 pages
- 1 (one) package 3"x5" lined assorted color index cards (blue, green, pink, yellow), 100 count
- 1 (one) standard book cover

History:

- 1 (one) 1½"-2" three-ring binder, hard cover with clear-view plastic cover
- 1 (one) set of 8-tab dividers
- 3 (three) packs 3"x5" index cards (100 count each - blue, green, yellow)
- 1 (one) pack of 50 sheet protectors
- 1 (one) set of highlighters, 4 different colors

Economics (returning students should use same binder from 7th grade):

- 1 (one) 1" three-ring binder, hard cover
- 1 (one) set of 5-tab dividers

Spanish:

- 1 (one) Avery Ultra Tabs Repositionable Margin Tabs, 2.5" x 1", 24 pack
- 1 (one) 5 subject three-hole punched spiral notebook with pockets, 200 pages

Mandarin (returning students may use same binder and supplies from 7th grade):

- 1 (one) glue stick
- 1 (one) black Sharpie marker
- 1 (one) 2" three-ring binder with clear view plastic covers on the outside and pockets on the inside
- 1 (one) set of 5-tab dividers

Please note:

- It is the responsibility of each student to replenish the above supplies as needed throughout the year.
- NO wheeled backpacks are allowed.
- No liquid paper, "dryline" only.
